Integrity Defined

1. The quality of being honest and having strong moral principles; moral uprightness
2. The state of being whole and undivided
 - The condition of being unified, unimpaired, or sound in construction
 - Internal consistency or lack of corruption in electronic data

Integrity Defined (personal definition):

A lifestyle of making consistent quality decisions, a righteous disposition; an unchanging biblically sound moral standard understood and accepted by the household of faith that one is held accountable

Becoming a People of Integrity

1. Place high value on God and the things of God (Phil. 4:9)
2. Identify a man of integrity and follow him as he follows Christ & pray for him (1Cor. 4:17; 1Tim. 2:2)
3. Confer value on fathers and mothers in the faith (Eph. 6:1; Heb. 6:12)
4. It takes a man of integrity to endorse you as a person of integrity (1Cor. 4:17)
5. Those closest to you can affirm you as a person of integrity
