PERSONAL PRAYER ALTAR

The Personal Prayer Altar is a place where you and God meet. It's a time of communion and dialogue. You receive your marching orders here. Consider it your time each day to check in with Headquarters!

He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.

- Psalm 91:1 [KJV]

What Is the Prayer Altar?

1. **A Physical Place** – there can be a special place in our homes for our time with God; more importantly, there is a special place in our hearts no matter where we are; we are the sanctuary
2. **A Specific Time** – we set apart a time in the day that is our time with God; although it is routine, this is holy
3. **A Discipline** – we develop the habit of going into the secret place; we also develop the discipline of **digging deep** every time we are in the presence of God

Whatever routine you value, eventually becomes a delight.

Components of the Prayer Altar

1. **The Word of God** – we read chapters at a time [starting with the smallest amount; a read-through-the-bible schedule helps establish this discipline]
2. **Praise & Worship** – we hallow the name of the Lord; recall the great things He has done; we do what it takes to draw the presence of God into the atmosphere (worship music, singing, etc.)
3. **Repentance & Intercession** – we humble ourselves in His presence through repentance; we receive His forgiveness and apply the Blood of Jesus to our lives; we then put on the full armor of God; this prepares us and moves us to pray for others
4. **Thanksgiving** – we then thank God for providing us all the answers to our prayers
5. **Confession** – we speak over our health, our families, our leaders, our nation and the nations of the world, including the peace of Jerusalem.
