 - 2. The Victory Shout Precedes the Victory
 - 3. Not Uncultured (not without a purpose)

Sporting Event example

Fans make a great sound = Champion makes a great play

"You'll hear a great sound that's commensurate with the perception of the greatness of the play. You never go to the Super Bowl and have a great play and a little sound from the fans. It's an unfair exchange." ~Phil Driscoll

Heaven's Record – Dr. Phil Driscoll
2Chronicles 20:20

“When the children of Israel were surrounded by three armies, they sent out the praisers ahead of the army. And God set up ambushments. Why? It's because heaven recorded the sound of victory. And they performed according to the sound that they heard. (Because we call those things that be not as though they were as believers; that's what faith is).

“When you lose, it's never a great sound. They don't have loser's dances and they don't have loser's parties.

“Praise helps us enter into the realm of eternity. Heaven recorded the sound of them praising God, that it activated heaven's firepower against their enemy.”

ii. God's Desires for Warfare Praise

1. Bringing the Victory (**Numbers 10:9**)
2. The Enemy's Defeat (Gen. 49:8)
3. Praise Goes First (**Judges 1:1-2**); the warrior king
4. Perfected Praise Provokes God's Warrior Side (Ps. 8:2)
5. Praise Is a Gate of Victory (Ps. 118:19-20)
6. Praise & the Word: The Victory Combo! (**Ps. 149:6-9**)

iii. High Praise

1. The Intense Level of Praise
2. Heaven's Praise Invading Earth
3. The Two-Edged Sword: The Word of God

iv. Accelerated Answers to Prayer

1. Announce God's Word.
2. Declare His Victory.
3. Rise Above the Situation.
4. Thank Him for the Favorable Outcome.

- d. The Sound of War
 - i. Roar of Rushing Water (Ez. 1:24; Rev. 19:6)
 - ii. "...praise takes the lid off the possibilities, because it simply confesses and rejoices in the absolute ability of God to be exactly who He is in the situation at hand."
 - iii. Magnify the Lord: enlarge your conception of Him!

- e. Preparing for War
 - i. Do not neglect prayer (inquiring of the Lord) (2Sam. 2:1; 1Thes. 5:17; 1Tim. 2:8)
 - ii. Do not neglect the Church (Heb. 10:25)
 - iii. Stay put during the time of training

- f. Engaging in Battle
 - i. Be on One Accord
 - ii. Engage into High Praise
 - iii. Replace the Rehearsal with Warfare Praise
 - iv. Stand Firm until Breakthrough
